7	Librarian	01	1. A Master's Degree in Library Science / Information Science / Documentation Science or equivalent Professional degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and a consistently good academic record with knowledge of computerization of library. 2. Qualifying in the national level test conducted for the purpose by the UGC or any other agency approved by the UGC. 3. However, candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in accordance with the "University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of University Assistant - Director of Physical Education / College Director of Physical Education & Sports.

Note:

1. A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level.
1. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled (a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
2. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
4. For the open posts candidates from backward classes as well as physically challenged persons can also apply.
 2. The reservation for women and physically challenged persons shall be as per the Govt. of Maharashtra rules.

Pay Scale: As per the U.G.C and the State Government.

Mode of applications:

1. Duty-qualified candidate shall apply therewith certified copies of the certificates/mark-sheets so as to reach the President of the Trust, on the above address from the date of publication of the advertisement in newspaper.
2. Candidates already employed shall apply through proper channel and shall submit 'NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE' from the present employer alongwith the application and also bring the same at the time of interview.
